*An early variety with stable yield and high protein content*



## Variety properties

- Early variety
- Two-row winter brewery barley
- High yield potential
- A plant of medium growth
- Large grain and high hectoliter
- High proportion of Class I grains



## Agro-technical characteristics

- Resistance to lodging: application of growth regulators
- Intensive drilling
- Sowing norm: 350 - 400 germinating grains / m<sup>2</sup>
- Optimal sowing date: 1.-20. October
- Good resistance to winter temperatures



## Disease resistance

- Rhynchosporium: tolerant
- Leaf rust: moderately tolerant
- Mosaic virus: tolerant
- Helminthosporium: moderately tolerant



## Malting properties

- Malt of very good qualities
- High extract content
- Favorable protein content in malt
