Medium-early variety with stable yield and optimal malting properties!



Variety characteristic

- › Medium early variety
- › Two-row winter malting barley
- › High yield potential
- › A plant of medium growth
- › Large grain and high hectoliter
- › High proportion of first-class grains



Agro-technical characteristics

- › Resistance to lodging: application of growth regulators
- › Intense pounding
- › Sowing rate: 350 - 400 germinating grains/m²
- › Optimum sowing time: October 5 - 20
- › Good resistance to low temperatures



Disease resistance

- › Gray spotting
- › Leaf rust
- › Reticulate spotting
- › Mosaic virus



Malting characteristics

- › Excellent calibration
- › Low protein content
- › Malt of very good quality
